From the Head Pro

I want to thank everyone for being so kind to me as I am getting acquainted with the Macon area and the Brickyard as well. I am still working on putting names and faces together, so please be patient with me for a little while longer.

There have been several issues brought to my attention in my first couple of weeks and I will begin addressing them in a timely order. My first concern is pace of play. I believe a round of 18 holes should not take 5 hours.

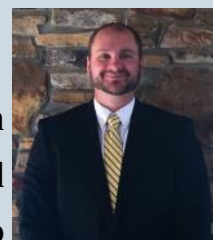
I have a pace of play chart that maps out how long each hole should take so that the group will finish in 4 hours. I also have another chart that maps out a 4 hour and 20 minute round. I will start getting out on the course and monitoring pace of play of groups and let them know if they are on pace, behind pace or ahead of pace. By playing in a timely fashion, I believe more members will have a better experience (especially in this heat) by finishing in under 4 hours and 20 minutes.

Weekday rounds will have a “time par” of 4 hours (4:20 when cart path only) while Weekend rounds will have a “time par” of 4 hours and 20 minutes (4:40 when cart path only).

Now, I may not be able to see everyone everyday on the course, so I will need your help to monitor pace of play (especially within your group) to help with this issue and allow everyone to have a good experience here at The Brickyard.

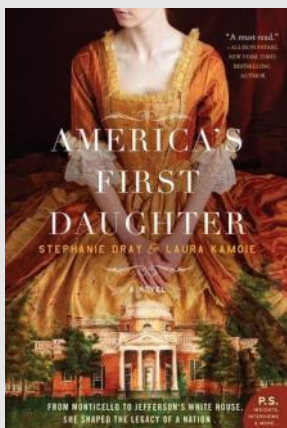
