A note from the Superintendent

Please remember to help with cart traffic and follow the 90^{*} rule. These photos help show what happens when we do not follow the 90^{*} rule. I took this picture on hole #1 where the cart path turns to go around to the right side of the fairway. We are seeing the turf grass being really worn down from golfers going straight instead of following the path (pic 1). Please remember to follow the path until you are even with your ball and then turn off of the path to proceed to the ball (pic 2).

This will help provide a better playing surface for everyone! Thanks, and see you on the course!!


