

### A Note from your Course Superintendent

ell, we survived a fairly mild January. Let's hope this month doesn't turn too cold on us. The weather cooperated and we were able to get a few of the projects done that we wanted to in January.

We fixed the drainage issue to the right of the #5 green. There is an underground water source that keeps the ground wet in that area. We dug out all around the problem area and added drain lines and

gravel to the existing catch basin. We then filled in the whole area with gravel and topped that off with landscape fabric, sand, and sod. The sod will take a while to fill in so we will keep that area ground under repair.

We installed a catch basin to the left of the #12 rough where the water would wash out under the big oak tree. We installed some sod around the new catch basin, so we will also keep this area ground under repair for a little while.

We installed a new sidewalk on the backside of the clubhouse by the #1 tee. This gives everyone a clear walking path from the tee up to the grill/back patio area.

We took down and cleaned up some of the dead trees around the course. We took down the tree to the right of #6 that was hit by lightning, the tree on #4 that was killed by pine beetles, and the tree to the right of #1 that was hit by lightning. We cleaned up a couple of downed trees to the right of #3, the downed tree to the left of #12, and the downed trees to the left of #11.

We have finished our winter tree pruning program and started cutting back the cordgrass throughout the course. We will continue that through February.

I have sprayed all the weeds on the course in January and they should start dying out soon. We have scheduled our spring pre-emerge/fertilizer for the 9<sup>th</sup> of March. That is done on a Monday, and then on Tuesday, March 10<sup>th</sup>, we will be cart path only. This will help ensure that the chemicals will soak into the soil and that the carts will not burn the grass driving over it. Sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.

## Brickyard Hole-In-One Club

#### **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. The Brickyard Hole-In-One Club rewards the golfer who is fortunate enough to make a hole-in-one at the Brickyard.
- When an ace is scored, every member registered in the Hole-In-One Club will be charged \$5.00 This amount is then given to the golfer as Pro-Shop and Food and Beverage credit.
- 3. The Brickyard Hole-In-One Club is open only to Brickyard members and spouses.
- If a member makes a hole-in-one and is not on the official roster, they will not receive credit.

#### To Claim a Hole-In-One:

- 1. The Member must be on the official Hole-In-One-Club roster
- 2. The Member must have been signed up to play 9 or 18 holes that day
- 3. The Member must have at least **two adult** witnesses



The Official Hole-In-One Club Roster will be kept in the pro-shop. If you are not on the list and would like to be added, please contact the pro shop. A member who wishes to be included or removed from the Hole-In-One Club must sign and date the necessary paperwork.

If your name is on the official list, you are in the Hole-In-One Club and will be charged \$5.00 when someone scores an ace. If you do not want to be in the club, you must call or visit the golf shop for specific notification. The golf shop staff will make a detailed record of the date and time that notification was given, which will be kept on file. The golf shop staff will modify the official list by initialing next to the person's name.


