A Note from the Head Superintendent

With November upon us, it means time for cold weather. We have taken all of the necessary measures to help all turf areas make it through the cold winter months. Throughout November, we will be continually cleaning up debris on the course as all the leaves will be dropping from the trees. We will also start doing some tree cleanup as we have a few trees along the course that have died. Keeping the course clean and playable will be our main focus.

We have also taken the necessary measures to maintain the health of the greens and to get them through the winter months. We have slowly raised the height of the greens to .140 and added phosphorous to them to help the plants store nutrients throughout the winter. We will slow down on mowing and roll them a little more often to reduce any stress and to keep them smooth.

As you all know, the course is extremely dry. The last measurable amount of rain, as of this writing (October 22), was on September 12th. We have only received 7.80 inches of rain since June 1st, through the hottest months of the year. We have gone very conservative in the water management. The ponds are all at critical levels. With that being said, we made it to the cool months!!!! We have alternated watering the fairways and tees, as well as watering the greens every night. The roughs have been sacrificed to get us through, but will recover if we EVER get rain again. Thank you for understanding the situation.

November Golf Tip

The Brickyard Golf Club is one of the more scenic courses in the state of Georgia. The rolling terrain mixed with the elevation changes make this course the most interesting club in Central Georgia. That being said, the lies that these hills and slopes provide adds to the challenge of hitting solid golf shots.

With that in mind, here are a few tips to help you handle these situations:

1. Aim more towards the higher part of the hill as your ball will always favor the opposite direction.
2. Always take practice swings and pay attention to where the club sweeps the grass. That will determine the appropriate ball position for the lie.
3. Ball above your feet: club up and choke down.
4. Ball below your feet: any move up and out of your posture will result in a thin, missed shot. Bend your knees and stay there!

These are just some quick, easy tips. If you have any questions on these shots, please stop by the golf shop anytime.

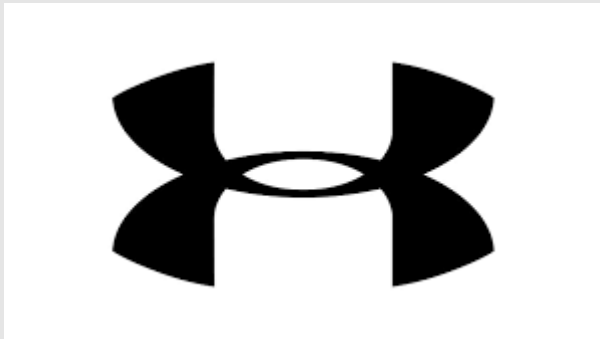
