

January Golf Tip

With the weather staying cold, and getting colder, it is hard to make yourself take off the layers and swing a golf club. This is why the winter can be a great time to practice your putting! Putting is the most important part of your short game and the easiest way to shave a few strokes off of your score. Practicing can be boring though, so here are a few ways to liven up your practice:

Play Games—putting games are a great way to keep your mind focused on what you are doing. One game you can try is called **Around the World**. Place 4 balls about 3 feet from the cup, 4 balls about 6 feet, and 4 balls at 9 feet. Start with the 3 footers. Once you have made all of those, move back to the six footers and so on. This game puts an emphasis on consistent putts. You can even add rules like returning to the previous putt when you miss one.

Practice Like You Play—to have an effective putting practice, you need to make it as similar to putting on the course during a round as possible. When you are on the practice green, do the same pre-shot routine that you do on the golf course. Practicing with your pre-shot routine will help you be more consistent during your round and it will help you to focus when the pressure is on.

Keep Stats—keep statistics on your putting during practice. Giving yourself goals to beat the next time that you practice. This helps you have specific goals in mind when you head out to the practice green and have a more productive practice.

Brick Cup Playoffs 2017

Starting in 2017, the Brickyard Golf Association will have a yearlong point system for members to accrue points to qualify for the 32 man Brick Cup held at the end of the year. Inspired by the Fedex Cup, there will be awards for the top 5 points winners and the top 32 will compete in a one day team competition for bragging rights!

1st Place—Member Guest tournament fees waves the following years

2nd Place—Two months of membership dues waived

3rd Place—\$200 pro shop credit

4th Place—\$100 pro shop credit

5th Place—\$50 pro shop credit

Points Awarded:

Dixie Classic = 30 points

Member Guest = 20 points

Member Member and Club Championship = 10 points

One day events/tournaments = 5 points

Thursday Night Mixer 9 hole events = 1 points



Bonus points will be awarded to members placing 1st—3rd in their flights in the Dixie, Member Guest, Member Member, and Club Championship:

1st—5 points

2nd—3 points

3rd—1 points

The top 32 point winners will qualify for a one day tournament compliments of the Brickyard Golf Association. The tournament will consist of two teams of 16. The winning team will win a special item (along the lines of a pullover or jacket) with a Brick Cup Champions insignia.

This will be unique among the club and signify the winning team. The losing team, on the other hand, will be responsible for paying for the winning team's items!

The winning team will also be eligible to compete against other clubs the following season. The point system will begin in January and we will give updates on the standings each month in the newsletter.


